#### **Program**

Day 1

Individual arrival at Schoppernau, welcome by the mountain guide and handover of rental equipment at Sport Matt. Depending on the conditions, we will start our tour directly in Schoppernau. Luggage can then be transported by taxi to Schönenbach. Along the way, you will be given tips on hiking technique, an introduction to avalanche theory and use of emergency equipment. (Distance: 5 km, Hiking time 2.5 hours, Ascent/Decent: 500/250 vertical meters).

Day 2

Today, we will start out directly from the very peaceful location of the Jagdhaus Egender for a tour around Schönenbach. At the end of our tour, a taxi will take us back to Schoppernau. (Distance: 5 km, Hiking time 2.5 hours, Ascent/Descent: 500/250 vertical meters)
